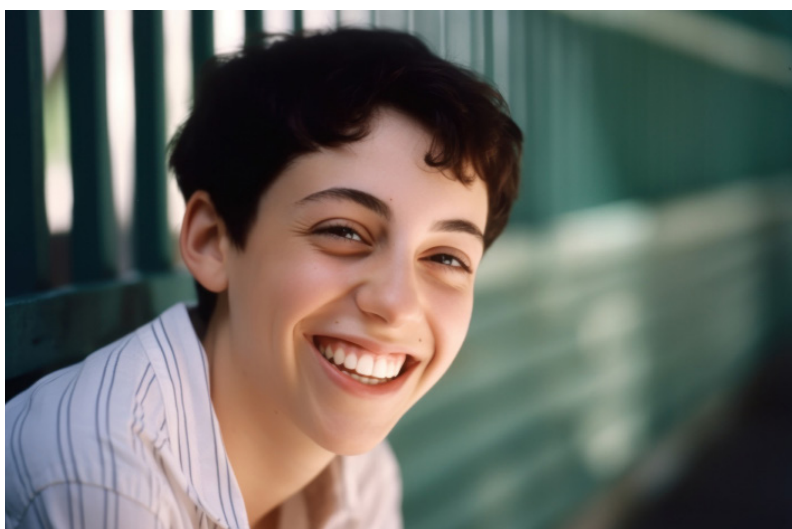

Employing a holistic approach, our program focuses on establishing a robust foundation for self-sufficiency through personalized care management and teaching essential life skills, as well as fostering a community of women who share similar life experiences. Situated in the Capitol Hill neighborhood, our agency takes pride in playing a vital role in the lives of women striving for a bright future. Donation Ideas

Every wish list item donated, from hygiene supplies to art supplies, lets us foster a clean and comfortable environment for the participants of Jubilee.

Hygiene supplies: Full-sized and unopened shampoo, conditioner, lotion, deodorant, razors, face wash, body wash, make-up, soap, toothpaste, etc. No travel sizes, please!

Cleaning supplies: White vinegar, natural all-purpose cleaner, dish soap, sponges, hand soap, heavy duty garbage bags, everyday garbage bags, spray bottles, disposable gloves, laundry detergent for HE washers, compostable biobags, bar/kitchen towels, etc.

Paper products: Toilet paper, paper towels, toilet seat covers, facial tissues

Pantry staples and shelf stable snacks: Unopened and unexpired grains, cereals, pasta, canned goods, spices, vinegars, flour, sugar, baking soda/ powder, granola bars, chips, snacks, teas, etc.

Kitchen supplies: Ziploc bags, plastic wrap, aluminum foil, parchment paper, food safe storage containers, dishes, cups, silverware, baking tools, coffee makers, electric kettles, mugs, lightly used appliances, etc.

Socks and underwear: We are only able to accept NEW socks and undergarments.

New bedding: New pillows, twin/full size sheet sets, twin/full size duvets, twin/full size mattress toppers and covers, etc.

Craft/art supplies: New or lightly used crochet hooks, canvases, air dry/ polymer clay, yarn, embroidery supplies, paints and brushes, colored pencils, sketch pads, etc.

Gardening supplies: Spades, seeds, starts, gloves, rakes, trimmers, etc.

Gift cards: Safeway, QFC, Fred Meyer, Target, Amazon, Costco, Home Depot, Lowes, etc.

Women's Clothing Donations

If you have in-season, consignment-quality, women's clothing, shoes, and accessories you are no longer wearing, they can still make a huge impact. Jubilee's biggest resource is our free clothing boutique for residents, alumnae and low-income women in the community who would otherwise be unable to afford quality items. The clothing you donated becomes interview attire, a new job wardrobe, fitness-enabling athletic wear, a special event ensemble, or everyday pieces that make a woman feel dignified and confident.

We accept donations at our main building on Capitol Hill between 9am & 4pm Monday-Friday. Please note, we are unable to take donations of large household items unless an arrangement has been made with staff prior to drop off.

Women's clothing donations that exceed our needs and storage capacity will be shared with community partners.



Drive and Fundraising Ideas

Whether it's a charity event for a club, a way to build camaraderie amongst co-workers, a fundraiser for a sorority or fraternity, or just a really fun gathering with your closest family and friends — coming together to make a difference is a wonderful way to engage with your community!

Below, you'll find some drive and fundraiser ideas to ponder, but don't hesitate to let your imagination run wild and explore ideas beyond these suggestions.

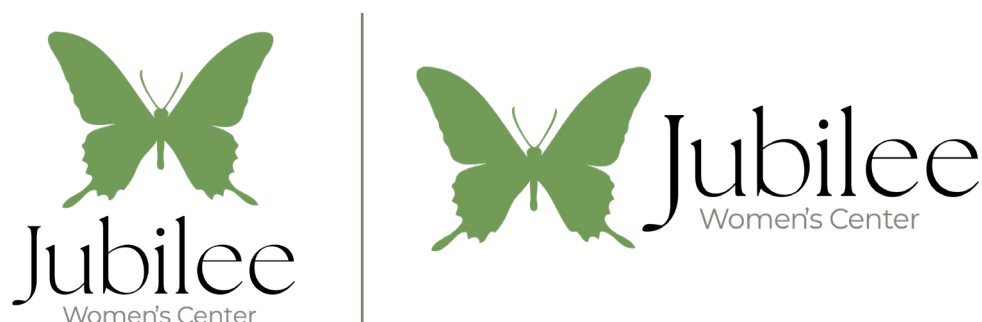
For more information and to kick start the process, please reach out to us at donations@jwcenter.org.

- Ask peers to bring items from Jubilee's Wish List as "admission" to a social gathering, association meeting, etc.
- Bake sales, lemonade stands, and car washes are good, old-fashioned fundraisers that suit a range of ages.
- Host a brunch, cocktail, or dinner party and ask guests for a "suggested donation" to benefit Jubilee.
- Clean out your stuff and raise money for a good cause with a yard sale.
- Set up a personal fundraising page or Facebook fundraiser to benefit Jubilee, and tell your contacts why this cause is important to you.
- Toilet paper drives are a hit with students!
- Give instead of gift: Ask for donations to Jubilee in your honor instead of gifts for holidays, birthdays, weddings, etc.
- Bra drives are popular with women who don't get embarrassed easily. Contact us for the most needed sizes.
- Ask co-workers to bring in gently-worn women's clothing, shoes, and accessories for Jubilee's free boutique and help a low-income woman build a quality work wardrobe.



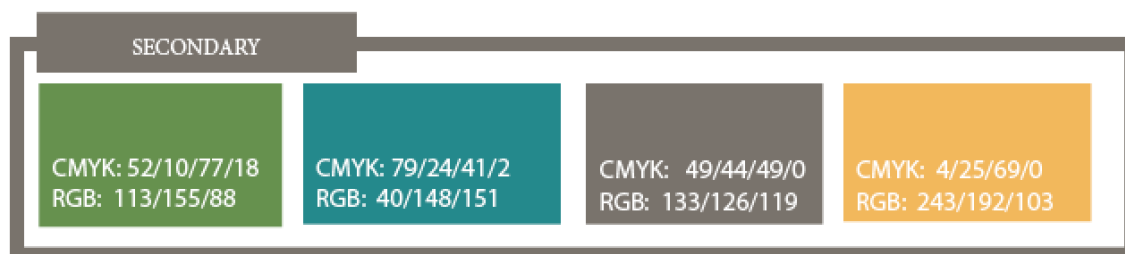
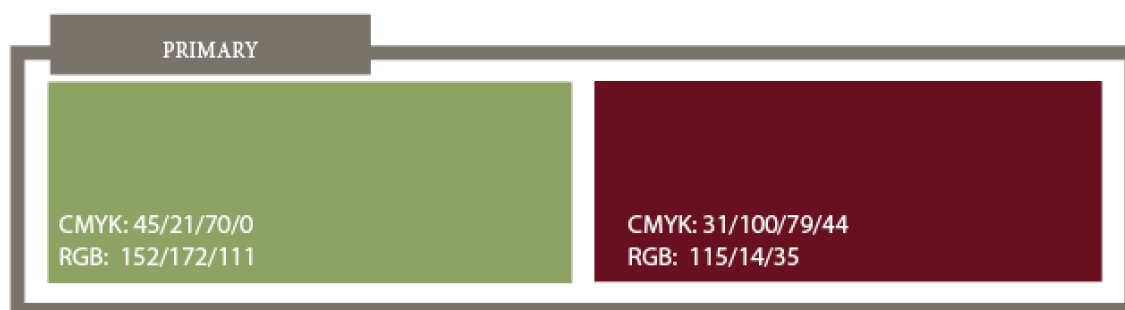
Logo and Color Usage

Residential Program

Jubilee's holistic program gives participants the stability and time they need to heal, grow, and rebuild their lives. At our three residences in Capitol Hill and one in the University District, the women we serve will find learning opportunities, employment preparation, and guidance from care managers as they work toward a living wage career and independent housing.

Community Services

Jubilee's free boutique offers clothing, shoes, personal items and accessories to women in need. In addition, Jubilee Women's Center provides referrals to other services in the community, and a confidential free computer lab.
